GENERAL EDUCATION ASSESSMENT AND REFINEMENT DRAFT

The General Education Subcommittee of the Council on Academic Affairs, represented by James Tidwell and Debra Reid, presented the General Education Assessment and Refinement Draft. The moratorium on changes to EIU's General Education curriculum ended in May 2004, and the Council on Academic Affairs would like to institute a departmental level review of General Education for the purpose of fine-tuning the existing curriculum. While EIU's compliance to the Illinois Articulation Initiative (IAI) will allow departments to consider courses that move beyond the IAI, current and proposed general education courses must still meet certain criteria outlined in the draft.

C. Roszkowski thanked the speakers on behalf of the LCBAS Curriculum Committee. C. Roszkowski (T. Hawkins) motioned to generally support the approach taken in the draft, particularly not restricting the General Education curriculum to those courses that meet IAI requirements. All approved.
