AGNES DHOM DIES  
AFTER LONG ILLNESS

*May 6, 1942*

Miss Teresa Agnes Dhom of Newton passed away Wednesday evening at St. Anthony's hospital, Effingham, where she had been taken a few days earlier. She has suffered from a kidney ailment for several years but recently had been much better. She became suddenly worse, however, and went into convulsions, from which she never recovered.

She was born in Newton, June 15, 1926, a daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Joseph Dhom.

She leaves, besides her parents, four sisters, Mrs. Sam (Mary) Ciesinski of Chicago, Mrs. Reuben (Angela) Jansen of Island Grove vicinity, and Misses Clara and Emily Dhom of Newton; other relatives and many friends.

Funeral services will be held at St. Thomas church in Newton, Saturday morning at 9:30 o'clock, and burial will be in Mount Calvary cemetery. Rev. Fr. Daniel Daly will officiate.
