CHARLESTON, IL--Thirteen Eastern Illinois University students have received 1984 Errett and Mazie Warner Presidential Awards. The awards are presented annually through endowments established by Warner, of Lawrenceville.

A 1925 graduate of Eastern, Warner served with the Illinois Bureau of Mines and Minerals from 1964 until his recent retirement.

He has held various teaching and administrative posts in public education in Illinois and was the Lawrence County Superintendent of Schools from 1955 to 1963.

Warner holds the Distinguished Alumnus Award from Eastern and is a past president of the Eastern Illinois University Foundation. Warner was a varsity football player at Eastern.

Scholarships from the Warner endowments are administered through the EIU Foundation.
