## REVIEWING THE WEEKEND (Nov. 14-15)

FOOTBALL: The Panthers clinched their second NCAA II playoff bid in three years with a convincing 52-13 win over Augustana. Eastern is now 9-2 with eight straight wins.

### MEN'S CROSS

COUNTRY: The Panthers finished seventh in the NCAA II National Championship. It was their lowest finish since 1972. Larry Schuldt (Rock Falls) was 27th, just missing All-American honors by two places. He covered the 10,000 meter course in 31:28. Humboldt (CA) State won with 115. EIU had 205. Other EIU finishers were Tim Warneke (Park Forest-Crete/Monee), 35th in 31:38; Mike Beresford (Danville), 56th in 31:57; Terry Donahue (Downers Grove-Montini), 63rd in 32:01; and Chuck Elliott (Palatine), 71st in 32:10. There were 180 runners.

SOCCER: Eastern was eliminated from the NCAA II tournament by losing to No. 1 ranked Lock Haven State, 3-1, in the Mideast-Midwest regional. Silvano Corazza scored EIU's only goal. The Panthers bowed out of the tournament with an 11-5 record.

### WOMEN'S CROSS

COUNTRY: The Panthers finished 14th in the AIAW II National Tournament. South Dakota State won with 82 points. EIU had 345. Dawn Campbell (Danville) led EIU with 46th place in 19:19 for the 3.1 mile course. Janet Steele (Charleston) was 68th in 19:36; Julie Curry (Highland), 71st in 19:41; Nancy Kramer (Decatur-McArthur), 77th in 19:45; Gina Sperry (Litchfield), 87th in 19:58; and Darlene Swank (Joliet-West), 91st in 20:05.

VOLLEYBALL: Eastern earned a berth in the AIAW II Midwest Regional by finishing second in the state AIAW Tournament at EIU this past weekend. The Panthers, seeded No. 6 in the regional, will play at Lewis University this Thursday through Saturday. Three Panthers were named to the state all-tournament team, Kathy Schoene (Trenton-Wesclin), Bonnie Fisk (Evansville, IN-Castle) and

Lesa Moore (Galesburg). EIU lost to Lewis in the championship match, 15-11, 15-5, and 15-6. En route to second place the Panthers disposed of Chicago State and Northeastern.
