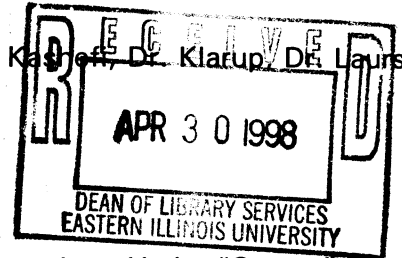

**I. Minutes**

The COSCC minutes of 4/9/98 were approved with the following correction: Under "Guests", change "Dr. Lenihan" to "Dr. Genie Lenihan".

**II. Communications and Announcements**

Vice-Chair Carwell announced that Dr. Gutowski would continue for another 3-year term as COSCC representative for the Geology-Geography Department. Communication Disorders and Sciences and Sociology-Anthropology have not named their representatives yet.

**III. Executive Action**

The following changes were approved by executive action to be effective Fall 1998:

1. ZOO 4810 – Change course number to 3810.
2. PLS 5023 – Change course title from "Contemporary Problems in International Politics" to "Proseminar in International Relations".
3. PLS 5543 – Change course title from "Seminar in Public Administration" to "Proseminar in Public Administration and Policy".
4. PLS 5073 – Change course description to read as follows: "An analysis of political behavior; political participation, voting behavior, political parties, interest groups, protest and theories of authoritarian behavior".
5. Engineering Program (B.S.) – Change the catalog wording of the program to include SIUC as another school to which Eastern students could transfer to complete the 5-year, dual-degree program.

**IV. Proposals**

**98:10. Proposed Change in the Political Science Major (M.A.)**

Dr. Klarup moved and Dr. Bernas seconded the motion to table this item to be acted on at the next meeting in conjunction with a new course proposal associated with the degree program.

**98:11. Proposed Public Administration Concentration for the Political Science Major (B.A.)**

Dr. Mueller presented the proposal and responded to questions from the committee members. Dr. Carwell moved and Dr. Bergmann seconded the motion to approve the proposal. The proposed concentration passed unanimously.

**98:12. New Course Proposal – Chemistry 5100. Advanced Analytical Chemistry. (3-0-3) On demand.**

Dr. Klarup presented the proposal and responded to questions from the committee members. Dr. Harris moved and Dr. Kashefi seconded the motion to approve the proposal. The new course proposal passed unanimously as amended.

**98:13. New Course Proposal – Political Science 5543. Proseminar in Comparative Politics (3-0-3).**

Dr. Carwell moved and Dr. Klarup seconded the motion to place the new course proposal on the agenda. Voting will be later.
