BURMESE FIGHTING ZONE FAMILIAR TO JOHN D. DAVIS

MAY 18, 1942
The territory in which the Chinese army trapped the Japanese mechanized army, Saturday and Sunday, annihilating the entire force, is well known to John D. Davis of Newton. In his several years as a salesman in the far east, he went through Burma several times. The last time, just before he returned home, he made the trip from Mandalay to Lashio, where the Burma road begins.

He has been familiar with almost every area in which the Japanese have attacked, except Australia, where he has never been, he stated Monday.
