DUNCAN SCHOLARSHIP BENEFITS FUTURE TEACHERS

CHARLESTON, IL--Sixteen Crawford County students have received the Ray C. and Evelyn B. Duncan Teaching Scholarship to attend Eastern Illinois University.

A \$250,000 bequest to the Eastern Illinois University Foundation from the estate of Ray C. Duncan, Robinson, funds scholarships for Crawford County residents who attend Eastern to obtain undergraduate teaching degrees. Mr. Duncan served as Crawford County Superintendent of Schools from 1952 to 1964. Nominations are made by Crawford County high school principals.
