The graduate courses will support the Master of Science in Educational

Guidance and Counseling and Technology and Technology Education. Courses

Information; EDG, Counseling Practicum; INT 5603, Advanced Manufacturing

Management & TED 5163, Contemporary Problems in Technology (both weekend formats).
