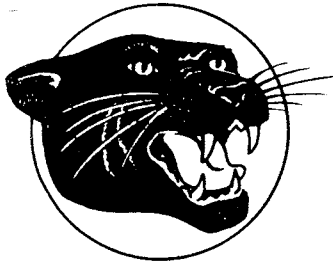

CHARLESTON, ILL (February 14, 1986)--The Eastern Illinois University athletic department announces that tickets for the IHSA Supersectional at EIU March 4 are on sale at Lantz Gym.

EIU season ticket holders and Panther Club members will have priority for purchasing tickets until February 21. After February 21, the tickets will go on sale to the general public. The price of the tickets are \$3 and can be purchased in the Lantz Gym ticket office from 9-4 p.m.--Monday through Friday.

CHARLESTON, ILL (February 14, 1986)--Eastern Illinois All-American quarterback SEAN PAYTON has been named an All-Sigma Chi football selection by the fraternity's national chapter.

The Naperville, Ill. junior is a member of the EIU Sigma-Chi chapter. He threw for more than 3100 yards and 22 TDs while leading the Panthers to 6-5 mark a year ago. Payton was named the ESPN Corning Amateur Athlete of the Week after passing for a school record 509 yards and four TDs against Saginaw Valley.

The selections are made annually from nominations submitted by any of the Fraternity's 193 undergraduate chapters who are varsity football players.

Previous honorees (with their collegiate and professional affiliations) include Merlin Olsen (Utah State, 1962), who was a linemen for the Los Angeles Rams; Bob Griese (Purdue, 1967), former Super Bowl quarterback for the Miami Dolphins; and Mark Herrmann (Purdue, 1981), a quarterback for the San Diego Chargers.
