EIU COURSES OFFERED IN THE DECATUR AREA

CHARLESTON, IL---Eastern Illinois University is offering Decatur area residents the opportunity to take classes at readily accessible Millikin University this summer semester.

Graduate courses offered at Millikin support the Masters in Elementary Education and Masters in Technology. Courses begin June 12. Graduate courses offered include EDA 5600, Introduction to Organization and Administration which is held on Saturdays beginning June 16. Also, EDF 5500, Curriculum Development; ELE 5650, Language Arts in Elementary School; and TED 5800, Seminar in Technology. A Graduate/Undergraduate course is also being offered in Industrial Technology. INT 4997, Industrial Safety Management will support the undergraduate programs offered at Millikin through EIU.

Courses will two evenings a week except for the Saturday class.
