ALGEBRA/PRE-CALCULUS WORKSHOP TO BE OFFERED

CHARLESTON -- A May 5 deadline has been set for those interested in registering for the workshop, "Algebra and Pre-calculus on a Microcomputer," to be held May 12 through June 6.

The course, to be taught by Suhrit Dey of Eastern Illinois University's math department, is designed for high school juniors/seniors and college freshmen/sophomores. Dey described the course as one where "TRUE-BASIC programming will be introduced to learn topics on algebra II and calculus. Students will write computer programs in PC's and experience the techniques applied to solve problems in algebra II and calculus. The following topics will be included: laws of indices, quadratic equations, lines, circles, parabolas, ellipses and hyperbolas, matrices, functions, limits, continuity and derivatives."

The class will meet from 7 to 9 p.m. Mondays and Thursdays in Eastern's Old Main, room 304. The cost is \$155 for one-hour credit and \$55 for non-credit. Those who are high school students may use it as escrow credit for Eastern or another university.
