CHARLESTON, IL--A two-day briefing on techniques of petroleum investigation and exploration will be conducted at the Holiday Inn in Olney by the Office of Public Service and Development at Eastern Illinois University.

Dates of the seminar are June 4-5. Director will be Dr. Alan Baharlou, Chairman of the Department of Geology-Geography at Eastern.

Baharlou said objectives of the repeat seminar at Olney are to:

Acquaint participants with fundamentals of geology and oil exploration;

Increase efficiency in exploration and production of oil and gas;

Enable participants to make more intelligent decisions about financial investments in oil and gas exploration and drilling;

Explore the language of exploration, drilling and production.

Baharlou said the seminar is designed for employees of the oil and gas industry, investors, developers and leaseholders.
