PALLISER HONORED

CHARLESTON, IL--Marye Palliser, whose parents Mr. and Mrs. John J. Palliser live in Norridge, has been named Editor-in-Chief of the 1990 "Warbler" yearbook at Eastern Illinois University.

Palliser, a 1986 graduate of Ridgewood High School, is a junior at Eastern majoring in Journalism.

As Editor-in-Chief of the yearbook, she will be responsible for administrative decisions, writing and design of the award-winning yearbook.

She was a Stringer/Correspondent for Lerner Newspapers, a subsidiary of Pulitzer Publishing Co., from June through September 1988 and for the past twelve months has been managing editor, copy editor and staff photographer for Heartland Magazine, an East Central Illinois publication.

She was also a staff writer for the 1986-87 Warbler and events editor for the 1987-88 Warbler, responsible for story ideas, editing stories, layout, composing and proofing of flats. Last year she was managing editor for the 1988-89 Warbler yearbook, responsible for staff activities, copy for publishing, editing of stories, writing stories and organization of the book.

In August 1988 she was named photo editor of Minority Today, a monthly publication for the Daily Eastern News that focuses on the minorities and foreign students of Eastern Illinois University.

Palliser is also a recipient of a Copley Outstanding Sophomore Scholarship, Member of Society of Collegiate Journalists, Member of Society for Professional Journalists, and has been nominated for numerous awards pertaining to journalism, many of which will be announced in May.
