MULTIMEDIA PRESENTATIONS SEMINAR

CHARLESTON -- Anyone interested in learning how to give better presentations is invited to a "Multimedia Presentations" seminar on Thursday at Eastern Illinois University.

Doug Davis, EIU physics professor, will show participants how to put pizzazz into their lectures or presentations by using multimedia presentations from a computer. A few presentations will be demonstrated during the 2 p.m. seminar in 215 Physical Science building.

The seminar is free and open to the public.

Individuals who use Macintosh computers for instructional or other purposes will find the seminar particularly informative, said Don Pakey, assistant professor of physics at Eastern.

There will be a discussion and demonstration of the capabilities of HyperCard, ClarisWorks and Astound. The physics department's INPUT capabilities will be demonstrated with a Canon Xapshot electronic still camera, VideoSpigot for QuickTime movies and a color flatbed scanner.

The presentation is part of the physics colloquium series sponsored by Eastern's physics department and faculty development, featuring talks about current topics in physics and other areas of special interest to students, faculty and the general public.
