CHINESE CONSUL-GENERAL TO SPEAK AT EIU

CHARLESTON -- Dongbi Huang, consul-general of the People's Republic of China, will present China's perspective on itself and its role to the nations of the world when he visits the campus of Eastern Illinois University next week.

The consul-general's talk, which will place special emphasis on China's relationship with the United States in the 21st century, will be a forthright review of China's rise as a potential super-power and the responsibilities it faces in helping to maintain world peace. Huang will be accompanied by three consuls who are in charge of education, science technology, and political sections, respectively.

Admission is free to the event which will take place at 4 p.m. Wednesday, May 27, in Lumpkin Hall, room 17. A question-and-answer session will follow.
