Chair Eckert called the meeting to order at 2:00 p.m.

**I. Minutes**

The minutes of 11/10/00 were approved as published.

**II. Executive Action**

1. CHM 2430 -- Change course offering, prerequisite, and last statement in course description so that course description reads as follows: "**2430 CHM. Survey of Organic Chemistry. (4-0-4) F, S.** Studies of aliphatic and aromatic compounds with an introduction to the theories of organic chemistry and reaction mechanisms. Prerequisite: CHM (1410, 1415) or (1510, 1515). No credit toward the chemistry major or Track II of the chemistry minor or for students with prior credit in CHM 2440. **EGR 963**"
2. CHM 2435 -- Change course title, course offering and course description to read as follows: "**2435 CHM. Survey of Organic Chemistry Laboratory. (0-3-1) F, S.** Laboratory experiments illustrating the major concepts of CHM 2430. Prerequisite: Concurrent enrollment of prior credit in CHM 2430. No credit toward the chemistry major or Track II of the chemistry minor or for students with prior credit in CHM 2445. **EGR 963**"
3. CHM 2440 -- Change prerequisite and last statement in course description to read as follows: "Prerequisite: CHM (1410, 1415) or (1510, 1515). Chemistry majors must elect CHM 2445 concurrently."
4. CHM 2840 -- Change prerequisite and add a statement to course description to read as follows: "Prerequisite: CHM 2440, 2445. Chemistry majors should elect CHM 2845 simultaneously. **EGR 964**"
5. CHM 3500 -- Change course offering, prerequisites and course description to read as follows: "**3500 CHM. Introduction to Chemical Research. (1-0-1) (Credit/No Credit) S.** An introduction to the ethical, safety and public awareness aspects of research in Chemistry; methods of searching for and retrieving chemical information from printed and electronic sources. Prerequisites: (CHM 2430, CHM 2435) or (CHM 2440, CHM 2445) or concurrent enrollment therein of 13 hours of chemistry or permission of the department chairperson."
6. CHM 4400 -- Change course description to read as follows: "Laboratory or theoretical research in which the student works under the supervision of a faculty member. A written report is required. Prerequisite or corequisite: CHM 3500; prerequisites: permission of the instructor and department chairperson. May be repeated for credit."
7. CHM 4800 -- Change course description to read as follows: "A course in a selected area of chemistry. May be repeated for credit if a different topic is taught. Prerequisite: CHM 3910 or permission of the instructor."

**III. Proposals**

**00-092. Proposed New Option in Radiation Physics (B.S.)**

Dr. Andrew presented the proposed option as revised and responded to questions from committee members. Dr. Scher moved and Dr. Miller seconded the motion to approve the proposal. The proposed new option passed. (YES -- Chesnut, Conwell, Eckert, Hake, Miller, Mueller, Scher, Kirkham; ABSTAIN -- Coulton)

**00-097. New Course Proposal -- Chemistry 2445. Organic Chemistry Laboratory I. (0-3-1) F, S.**

Dr. Keiter presented the proposal and responded to questions from committee members. Dr. Conwell

moved and Dr. Mueller seconded the motion to approve the course proposal. The new course proposal passed unanimously.

**00-098. Revised Course Proposal -- Chemistry 2845. Organic Chemistry Laboratory II. (0-6-2) F, S.**
