IV. Discussion of the Review of General Education Courses

Dr. Addison presented to the committee the proposed process for reviewing general education courses. CAA suggested that modified proposals for existing courses that have already been approved as part of the new general education program may go directly to the newly-established subcommittee of CAA unless the college curriculum committees decide to review them first. All proposals for new courses to be added to general education must go through the normal approval process.

Dr. Wohlstein and Assistant VPAA Herrington-Perry responded to questions from committee members including questions concerning introductory courses, cultural diversity courses, and assessment. Assistant VPAA Herrington-Perry requested that all proposals be submitted electronically.

After the discussion, Dr. Bruehler moved and Dr. Conwell seconded the motion for COSCC to review all general education course proposals. The motion passed unanimously.
