John Connor Wounded

June 7, 45

Mr. and Mrs. V. O. Connor received a message from the Navy Department this morning stating that their son, John, had been seriously wounded in the Pacific area. The message did not give the date of his injury.

John is known to have been serving on a destroyer in the Pacific waters but nothing is known concerning the exact theatre of operations he was in at the time of being wounded.
