CHARLESTON, IL--Peggy Brayfield, Eastern Illinois University professor of English and program coordinator of the Women's Studies Council, will speak on "Florence Nightingale, Empress of the Scavengers" at 2 p.m. Sunday (March 2) in the Booth Library Lecture Room.

This is the second of three spring public lectures sponsored by the EIU chapter of the American Association of University Professors. It is also part of the March events for Women's History and Awareness Month.

Dr. Brayfield's research on Florence Nightingale, supported by a grant from the University, was first presented at the National Women's Studies Association in 1974.
