CHARLESTON, IL--Mark Winternheimer, a student at Eastern Illinois University from Mt. Carmel, is a 1985 recipient of the Errett and Mazie Warner Presidential Award.

Awards in 12 categories are presented annually through endowments established by Warner, of Lawrenceville, and administered through the EIU Foundation.

Winternheimer's award was in the geography-geology area for his outstanding academic achievements. The award carried a framed certificate and a cash stipend. Mark was also on the Dean's List for the fall semester.

Warner is a 1925 graduate of Eastern. An outstanding athlete, he captained the football team during his senior year. He held various teaching and educational administrative posts in Illinois and was the Lawrence County Superintendent of Schools from 1955 to 1963.

He served with the Illinois Bureau of Mines and Minerals from 1964 until his recent retirement. Warner holds the Distinguished Alumnus Award from Eastern and is a past president of the EIU Foundation.

Warner personally presented the award to Winternheimer at a dinner attended by Dr. Stanley Rives, Eastern's president.

Winternheimer said "I was overwhelmed. The scholarship took me by surprise. It is really great that Mr. Warner is doing this kind of thing for Eastern."
