CHARLESTON, IL--Two Eastern Illinois University students from Charleston are among 1985 recipients of the Errett and Mazie Warner Presidential Awards.

Awards in 12 categories are presented annually through endowments established by Warner, of Lawrenceville, and administered through the EIU Foundation.

The recipients are Douglas Quivey, in the field of history, and David Bryden, mathematics. The awards recognize outstanding academic achievement and carry cash stipends and framed certificates.

Warner is a 1925 graduate of Eastern. An outstanding athlete, he captained the football team during his senior year. He held various teaching and educational administrative posts in Illinois and was the Lawrence County Superintendent of Schools from 1955 to 1963.

He served with the Illinois Bureau of Mines and Minerals from 1964 until his recent retirement. Warner holds the Distinguished Alumnus Award from Eastern and is a past president of the EIU Foundation.
