Revised Course Proposal – MIS 4850, Systems Security

Wollan presented the proposal. Motion made (Akalin) and seconded (McPhillips) to set aside committee bylaws and vote on the proposal to meet CAA/CGS deadline. Vote taken. Approved. Motion made (Akalin) and seconded (McPhillips) to approve the proposal with minor revisions. Vote taken. Approved.

Revised Course Proposal – MBA 5670, Management of Information Technologies

Wollan presented the proposal. Motion made (Akalin) and seconded (McPhillips) to place the proposal with minor revisions on the agenda for voting at the next meeting. Vote taken. Approved.

New Course Proposal – AET 4193, Database in Computer Technology

Liu presented the proposal. The committee raised concerns about this course overlapping with MIS 4200. Akalin will take the proposal to the MIS faculty and then bring it back to the committee for further discussion at the next meeting.

New Course Proposal – AET 3163, Programming in Computer Technology

Liu presented the proposal. The committee raised concerns about this course overlapping with three programming courses in the School of Business. Akalin will take the proposal to the MIS faculty and then bring it back to the committee for further discussion at the next meeting.

Revised Course Proposal – CTE 3000G, Consumers in the Marketplace

Drage presented the proposal. The committee requested that the director for the entrepreneurship minor be made aware of this proposal since CTE 3000 is offered as an elective in that minor. If it is approved as a general education course, it might be removed from the entrepreneurship minor. Motion made (McPhillips) and seconded (Akalin) to place the proposal with minor revisions on the agenda for voting at the next meeting. Vote taken. Approved.
