DOSS RECEIVES BUSINESS AWARDS

CHARLESTON -- Suzanne Doss, daughter of Joyce Doss of Danville, is the recipient of three awards from Eastern Illinois University's Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences.

They are the Administrative Information Systems Merit Award, the Cooley-Marathon Scholarship and the Business Education and Administrative Information Systems Departmental Award.

The Merit Award recipient is chosen by an Eastern faculty committee each year. This person is a top senior who has high academic achievement and possesses the characteristics of an individual who will succeed in the field of end-user computing.

Cooley-Marathon Scholarships were established by Rex and Nancy Cooley of Scottsdale, Ariz., and the Marathon Oil Foundation. A 1959 graduate of Eastern, Rex Cooley is retired from his position as senior vice president and comptroller for USX Corporation. He was honored in 1983 as the Distinguished Alumnus of the Lumpkin College of Business and received the university's Honorary Degree of Doctor of Laws in 1988.

The Departmental Award recipient is selected from among all senior students in the Department of Business Education and Administrative Information Systems by the faculty there.

Doss graduated this spring with an AIS major. She is a 1993 graduate of Bismarck-Henning High School in Bismarck.
