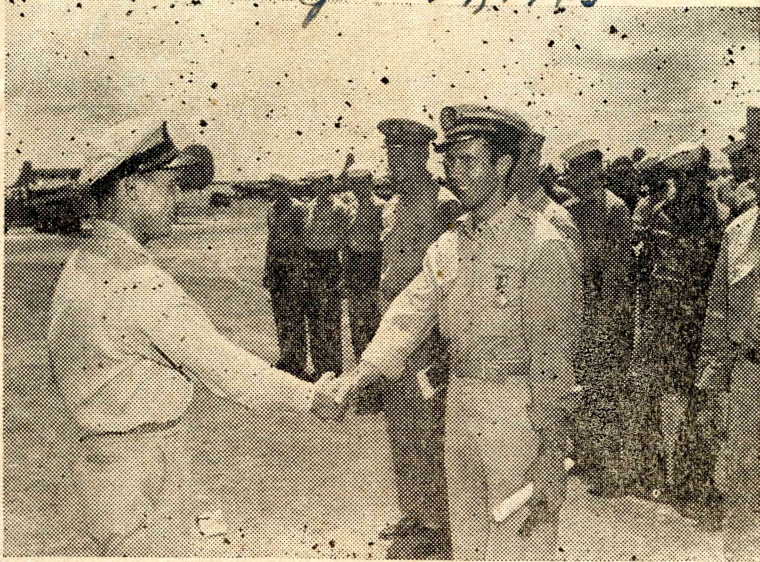

Lieutenant Schuch, who is home on leave, is co-pilot of a B-24 Liberator search plane. He recently had a unique experience which almost resulted fatally for the members of the crew when the plane was blown two hundred feet in the air and the controls jammed. Quick thinking and action by the pilot, co-pilot and all crew members brought it under control and enabled it to get back to base.
