SUMMER VISITORS

CHARLESTON, IL--Special programs at Eastern Illinois University will bring more than 1,600 visitors to Charleston this week (June 24-30).

The largest event is the Universal Cheerleading Camp, June 26-29, which will bring 500 visitors to the campus.

Another large event is a camp for an elite group of French horn players with 300 participants.

Approximately 300 Fall 1990 freshmen and transfer students will be on campus, June 24-29, to pre-enroll for classes.

Two sports camps, basketball and tennis, have more than 250 attendees.

The Fred Miller Clinic, a Marching Flag Corps, with 125 participants, will be on campus June 24-27.

Ninety-four Percy Julian High School students will be on campus to attend classes and earn college credit.
