EIU HONORS 901 YEARS OF SERVICE

CHARLESTON, IL--Eastern Illinois University honored 42 employees, with a total of 901 years of service, at its sixth annual dinner Saturday night (April 22).

Included were 18 civil service employees, honored for a total service of 331 years and five administrators, recognized for a total of 135 years of service.

Special recognition was also given to 19 faculty members having five or more years of teaching at EIU for a total of 435 years. Sixteen of the faculty have taught at EIU for 20 or more years.
