CHARLESTON, IL--The Eastern Illinois University/Community Orchestra will present its final concert of the 1984-85 season on Thursday, April 25 at 7:30 p.m. in Dvorak Hall.

The Concerto Concert will feature winners of the annual concerto competition as soloists. Jun-Jin Kim, of Seoul, Korea, will perform the first movement of the Concerto for Piano in C Major, K.503 by W.A. Mozart.

James Simonson, Mount Prospect, will perform the first two movements of the Hindemith Horn Concerto of 1949. The aria "Salce, Salce" from Verdi's "Othello" will be performed by Cathy Berns, of Ocone.
