CHARLESTON, IL--Dr. Foster C. Rinefort, Eastern Illinois University, will be the moderator for the third annual National Satellite Video Teleconference on May 8.

Sponsored by the National Safety Council, the seminar will deal with "Cost Containment Through Effective Safety and Health Programs."

The program will originate from WTTW-TV in Chicago. A satellite communications system will transmit the day-long live telecast to 31 receiving sites nationwide, including Chicago and St. Louis.

The teleconference will include discussions on ways to maximize reductions of work injuries and illnesses, while minimizing the cost of such programs.

Also included will be demonstrations of safety and industrial hygiene, medical and wellness programs, and loss control and worker's compensation.

Other members of the panel include Dr. Dan Petersen, author and consultant, Tucson, Ariz.; Dr. Brockton L. Weisenberger, director of corporate employees' health, Abbott Laboratories; Alice Barr, Parkside Medical Services Corp., Park Ridge; and Dr. Howard M. Sandler, president of Sandler Occupational Medicine Associates, Gaithersburg, Md.

Rinefort, Associate Professor, College of Business, has taught, published and consulted in the safety field for several years. He is a former safety engineer for Procter and Gamble and corporate manager of safety, International Minerals and Chemical Corp.
