MILLER AWARDED UNDERGRADUATE RESEARCH GRANT AT EIU

CHARLESTON – Sarah L. Miller, a senior theatre arts/psychology major at Eastern Illinois University, recently was awarded a Fall 2003 undergraduate research grant.

This \$500 grant, awarded by EIU's Undergraduate Research Council through the university's Honors Program, will allow Miller to perform research on "Aurand Harris' Contributions to Children's Theatre." More specifically, she will research, direct and tour the children's theatrical show, "The Arkansas Bear," during the coming school year.

To be eligible for an undergraduate research grant, a student must have a cumulative grade point average of 3.0 or higher, and be conducting research under the direction of a faculty sponsor. A limited number of such grants are awarded each semester.

Miller, a 1999 graduate of Unity High School in Tolono, is the daughter of Rosie Miller and the late Bruce Miller of Tolono. Her sponsor is Jean Wolski, a faculty member from Eastern's Department of Theatre Arts.
