CHARLESTON, ILL.--The Norfolk Southern Corp. has given \$1,000 to the Bertrand P. Holley Distinguished Professorship of Social Responsibility in Business at Eastern Illinois University.

Holley is retiring this summer after teaching for 41 years at Eastern. The check was presented to Dr. Ted Ivarie, Dean of the Lumpkin College of Business. Rep. Mike Weaver made the initial contact with Norfolk Southern.

Making the presentation was George J. Camille, Norfolk vice president. Ivarie said "the gift is symbolic of the responsible attitude Norfolk Southern has toward Charleston and Eastern Illinois University. The action is consistent with its corporate goals."
