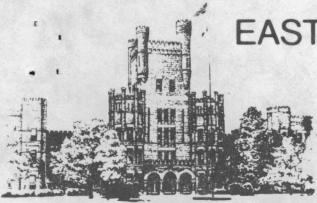

SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENT

Thomson is a 1987 graduate of Dieterich High School and is a junior majoring in French and political science at EIU. She is a member of the Association of Honors Students and has been named to the Dean's List at Eastern. She has also received the Ruth Carman Scholarship and the Bobbie King Memorial Scholarship.

The Ruth Carman Scholarship was established in memory of Ruth Carman, former professor of foreign languages at Eastern from 1914 to 1953. The award is given annually to an outstanding student in a foreign language.

The Bobbie King Memorial Scholarship was established in 1966 by Mr. and Mrs. Karl King of Charleston, Illinois, in memory of their daughter. The award is presented annually to a junior or senior demonstrating outstanding achievement in the study of foreign languages.

Honors Programs Scholarships are awarded to Eastern students who achieve high levels of scholarship while being active in the Honors Programs as well as in University and community affairs.
