CHARLESTON, IL--The gift shop in the Tarble Arts Center will open Monday, June 14, date of the first exhibit in the Center.

Basic aim of the shop is "making original art as affordable as possible," according to Mrs. Ruth Jaenike, volunteer coordinator of the operation.

Mrs. Jaenike will direct ten docents (museum guides), all of whom are volunteers. Items for sale will be in two major categories: original art and crafts and items obtained from other museums.

All the merchandise will be museum-related "and unique to gallery operations such as found in virtually all similar institutions."

Included in the original arts category will be works from local and area artists, Mrs. Jaenike said. She added that "we want to appeal to the arts appetites of children, students, and the general public."

Assisting Mrs. Jaenike in selecting gifts is an arts advisory committee. Members are Garret DeRuiter, Phil Settle and William Heyduck, all of Eastern's Art Faculty.
