CHARLESTON, IL--Staff members of a U.S. House of Representatives' committee charged with writing legislation for reauthorization of the Vocational Education Act will take part in a Distinguished Visiting Faculty Workshop at Eastern Illinois University Aug. 2-5.

Conducting the workshop on "The Future of Vocational Education" will be James R. Galloway, Assistant State Superintendent, Department of Adult, Vocational, and Technical Education, Illinois Office of Education.

Dr. Charles Switzer, Director of Summer School, said the workshop will involve "issues, concerns and future of state and national policy on education, employment and training." The workshop is designed for school administrators and vocational teachers, he said.

Appearing on Aug. 4 will be Charles W. Radcliffe, minority counsel, and Jack Jennings, majority counsel, of the House of Representatives' Committee on Education and Labor. Both are staff directors of the committee.

Other workshop leaders will be Carol Rhea, Associate Executive Director, State Advisory Council for Adult, Vocational and Technical Education (Aug. 2);

Don Gentry, Indiana State Director of Vocational Education (Aug. 3);

Dr. David Baker, Assistant Executive Director, state Chamber of Commerce (Aug. 5);

And, Dr. John Washburn, Manager of the Research and Development Unit, Department of Adult, Vocational and Technical Education (Aug. 5).
