CHARLESTON -- Brenda Volk, daughter of Bernard and Sylvia Volk of Ingraham, is the recipient of the Phi Beta Lambda Most Involved Member Award from Eastern Illinois University's Lumpkin College of Business and Applied Sciences.

The award is given to an active member who contributes significantly to the growth and advancement of the local chapter, and maintains a minimum GPA of 2.5. The recipient also must be motivated and participate in fundraising and recruitment activities.
