SGT. PAUL STANLEY HAS 5 BATTLE STARS

May 3, 1945-

SERVING IN ITALY WITH FIGHTER
BOMBER COMMAND

At a 12th AAF P-47 Base in Italy—Staff Sgt. Paul E. Stanley, son of N. A. Stanley of Newton, Ill., now wears five bronze battle stars on his theatre ribbon for having taken part in five major campaigns.—the Tunisian, Sicilian, two phases of the Italian and Southern France.

Sergeant Stanley has shared the dangers and hardships of life in a fast moving tactical fighter group, which has been awarded the War Department Unit Citation for outstanding performance of duty.

Overseas more than 30 months, Sgt. Stanley is with a veteran fighter-bomber group of the 12th Air Force, which is actively engaged in dive-bombing and strafing of enemy military installations in the Po Valley and the Brenner Pass.
