CHARLESTON, IL--"A commitment by young people to support a community art facility."

That's the way Dr. Vaughn Jaenike, Dean of the College of Fine Arts at Eastern Illinois University, described the Performing Arts Club at Charleston High School.

The occasion was a \$500 donation by the Club to the Tarble Arts Center through the EIU Foundation. Alice Jayne Swickard, the Club's faculty sponsor, said the members were "Young philanthropists who wanted to help the Arts Center."

The money was raised through productions at the high school. Mrs. Swickard said it was hoped that the donation "was the first of several" in succeeding years. Jaenike said the amount of the gift ranked the Club in the "sustaining patron" category of Tarble memberships.
