MCCOY HONORED

CHARLESTON, IL--Sherry McCoy, a junior Accounting and Finance double major at Eastern Illinois University, has been honored with three different scholarships for 1988.

McCoy, a 1986 graduate from Martinsville High School, is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Maurice McCoy of Martinsville.

McCoy first received the prestigious Hobert F. Heller Scholarship. The \$500 scholarship was established in honor of Dr. Hobert F. Heller, who was Vice President for Instruction and a member of Eastern's faculty for 36 years. The award goes annually

to one student nominated by a member of Eastern's faculty, with selection made by a committee headed by the University's chief student personnel officer.

Dr. Lowell Bourne, chairperson of Accountancy, Data Processing, and Finance, nominated McCoy. "She is an outstanding model student and is very deserving of the award," said Bourne.

McCoy also received the Mr. and Mrs. William Craig Simmons Scholarship. The \$200 scholarship award was established by members of the Simmons family. Selection is made by faculty members of the College of Business and awarded annually to a junior business major on the basis of outstanding personal character and scholastic achievement.

McCoy also received the Eunice W. Dougherty Scholarship. The award was established by a bequest of Eunice W. Dougherty. The \$500 scholarship award is given annually to an outstanding junior enrolled in programs administered through the College of Business and the College of Arts and Sciences.

"I am very honored to have received the awards. It has inspired me to continue to work hard at school," said McCoy.

McCoy is a member of Eastern's Honors Program, and Delta Mu Delta, a national honor society in business administration. She participates in intramural volleyball, Eastern's residence hall council and works for Booth Library on campus.
