CHARLESTON, IL-'A Child's World: Tots, Toys, and Teens, 1820-1980', an exhibit at the Greenwood School Museum, 800 Hayes Avenue in Charleston, is open to the public from 1:30-3:30 beginning Sunday (March 23) through September 28.

Over 200 items used by children during the past 165 years explore the changing role of children and adolescents in American society since 1820.
