SPRINGFIELD, IL--Marion L. (Jake) Zane today was named Acting Vice President for Administration and Finance at Eastern Illinois University.

The appointment was made by the Board of Governors of State Colleges and Universities (BOG) upon recommendation of President Stanley Rives. Zane, treasurer at Eastern since 1979, will assume the position on July 1.

The office became vacant when Dr. George Miller resigned to accept the Vice Presidency for Administration and Finance at Kansas State University.

Zane first worked in the business office as a student. He was employed as an accountant in 1958 and since then has held a number of positions including controller, assistant to the director of business services, and purchasing agent.

A graduate of Paris High School, Zane has bachelor's and master's degrees from Eastern. He is a four-year Air Force veteran. Special assignments at Eastern have included membership in an implementation task force for the BOG common software project and a self-study committee for North Central Association Evaluation.

Community activities include the Charleston Rotary Club and the United Way Board. Mr. and Mrs. Zane are the parents of two daughters.
