CHARLESTON, IL --A lipreading class for persons with hearing losses will be held by Eastern Illinois University's Speech and Hearing Clinic, beginning Thursday, Sept. 24. The classes will meet each Thursday from 10 a.m. to 12 noon in Rooms 201 and 202 in the Clinical Services Building. There is no charge.

In addition to lipreading, information will be provided about hearing loss, hearing aids, and specialists who work with persons who have hearing difficulties.

Dr. Nancy Weiler, of the Speech and Pathology and Audiology Department, said spouses are encouraged to attend and share the information.

Interested persons may attend the first day of the class or they may call the Speech and Hearing Clinic (581-2712) to enroll or to obtain further information. Dr. Weiler said approximately 10 sessions are planned.
