CHARLESTON, IL--The list of persons who have commissioned Dean Fausett to paint their portraits reads like an international "Who's Who."

Included are Dwight Eisenhower, the Duke and Dutchess of Windsor, Sir Alexander Fleming, Hoagy Carmichael and Grandma Moses.

Fausett will be among the distinguished guests at the Tarble Arts Center dedication at Eastern Illinois University on Sunday, Sept. 26.

A special exhibit of his paintings will coincide with the dedication and will be shown at the Center from Sept. 23 to Oct. 23. On Thursday, Sept. 23, Fausett will present a public slide/lecture on his works at the Center at 7 p.m. A reception for the artist will follow the presentation.

Fausett is a muralist, portraitist and landscape artist. He is president of the National Mural Society and his paintings have been featured in many museums, including the Whitney, the Metropolitan, the Museum of Modern Art, and the Art Institute of Chicago.

Among his noted works is a painting of his home in Vermont which has a 350-year old maple tree in front. He exhibited the painting to support his testimony before the Vermont legislature on behalf of a historical preservation bill.

The Tarble Arts Center dedication will begin at 1:30 p.m. with a brass ensemble concert.
