CHARLESTON, IL--Dr. Eugene Bonelli, a Distinguished Visiting Professor at Eastern Illinois University's Summer School, will present a lecture on "The Development of the Arts District in Dallas," on Tuesday, June 26, at 7:30 p.m. in Phipps Lecture Hall on Eastern's campus. The lecture is free and open to the public.

Dr. Bonelli, Dean of the Meadows School of the Arts at Southern Methodist University, is teaching a workshop on the Arts as Catalyst for Urban Change: The Dallas Experience, June 25-28. Recently President of the International Council of Fine Arts Deans, Dr. Bonelli has been active in the cultural development of the Dallas area, serving on the Executive Board of the Dallas Symphony Orchestra, the Executive Board of the Dallas Opera, and as President of the Dallas City Music Association. A well-known authority on contemporary music, Dr. Bonelli has published two books and many articles on topics in music, music and fine arts administration, and faculty evaluation. Dean Bonelli received his PhD from the Eastman School of Music in 1970.
