# Friends Give Party For Returned Soldier

*May 24, 48*  
A neighborhood party was given last night at the Cummins church east of Rose Hill, honoring Pfc. James W. McCoy, a local boy who has recently returned home after having been released from a German Prison Camp.

After a supper served in the church yard, the friends and neighbors went into the church where a program was given. The highlight of the program was a talk given by the returned soldier, in which he recounted many of his experiences on the field of battle and while held as a prisoner of war by the Germans.

Pfc. McCoy is a son of Mr. and Mrs. Harry McCoy of the Cummins neighborhood.
