EASTERN ILLINOIS UNIVERSITY OFFERS COURSES IN DECATUR

CHARLESTON -- Eastern Illinois University will offer three fall semester courses at Richland College, 1 College Park, Decatur.

All courses are one-semester-hour workshops that carry either graduate or undergraduate credit and are offered on weekends. Learners attend class on Fridays from 6 to 10 p.m. and on Saturday from 8 a.m to 6 p.m.

"What Classroom Teachers Need to Know about HIV/AIDS" (HST 4998-120) will be held Oct. 5-6. "Universal Education and Government's Role" (PLS 3998-120) will meet Sept. 27-28. "The Psychology of Juvenile Criminal Behavior" (PSY 4997-120) will be offered Oct. 25-26.

A fourth EIU course will be taught at Woodrow Wilson Resource Center, Title One Center, 1100 West Sunset, Decatur. The course is a one-semester-hour workshop for either graduate or undergraduate credit. "Implementation of Health and Wellness Strategies in the Classroom, K-12" (HST 4998-121) will meet from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. on two Saturdays--Oct. 5 and Oct. 19.
