REYNOLDS COMPLETES UNIVERSITY HONORS PROGRAM

CHARLESTON -- Cynthia Reynolds, daughter of James and Barbara Reynolds of Sidney, recently completed the University Honors Program at Eastern Illinois University.

Reynolds, who graduated magna cum laude, received a bachelor's degree in elementary education at Eastern's Centennial Commencement, May 6.

The University Honors Program is designed for students who begin as freshmen at Eastern. It provides honors sections of required general education courses and upper division seminars. To complete the program, students must take a minimum of 25 hours in honors courses which will substitute for current general education courses.

Reynolds is a 1991 graduate of Unity High School, Tolono.

Eastern, which is celebrating its 100th anniversary in 1994-95, is a comprehensive university with more than 10,500 students and 46 undergraduate and 27 graduate degree programs. It is a teaching institution which prides itself on the quality and affordability of its undergraduate program.
