CHARLESTON, IL--Carolyn Wilke, a student at Eastern Illinois University from Belleville, is a 1985 recipient of the Livingston C. Lord Scholarship, the most prestigious award given by the University.

Based on academic excellence and extra curricular participation, the award is named in honor of Lord, the president who guided Eastern from its opening in 1899 until his death in 1933. It is the only scholarship personally presented by the University's president at spring commencement.

Given Saturday (May 11) by President Stanley Rives at commencement ceremonies, the award carries a stipend of \$2,500 and a medallion designating the recipient as a Lord Scholar.

Carolyn, a 1982 graduate of O'Fallon High School, is working toward a B.S. in Education degree and plans to teach when she graduates in the fall of 1985. She is the daughter of Mr. and Mrs. Norman Wilke, Route 2, Belleville.
