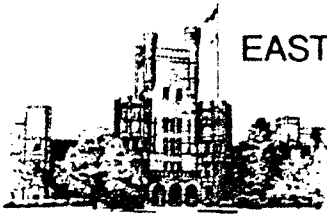

CHARLESTON, IL--Ms. Letty Cottin Pogrebin, a Distinguished Visiting Professor at Eastern Illinois University's summer school, will lecture on "Family Politics," on Friday, July 27, at 7 p.m. in the Grand Ballroom of the University Union. The lecture is free and open to the public.

Ms. Pogrebin, prominent author and lecturer, will teach a workshop on the "Changing Family: Love, Power and Politics," July 27-28.
