CHARLESTON, IL--Rochelle Johnson of suburban Norridge, is one of two 1983 recipients of the Livingston C. Lord Scholarship at Eastern Illinois University in Charleston, Ill.

Named in memory of the man who was the university's president from 1898 to 1933, the scholarship is the most prestigious award given at Eastern. The awards go annually to two students in recognition of outstanding academic achievement and character.

Each Lord scholar receives a certificate and stipend of \$2,000. The award is administered through the Eastern Illinois University Foundation.

Formal presentation of Ms. Johnson's award was made at spring commencement on Saturday, May 14.

The daughter of Mrs. Eileen Johnson, 4819 North Crescent, and the late Donald Johnson, Miss Johnson is a graduate of Ridgewood High School and an elementary education major at Eastern. She is a past recipient of EIU's President's Award which is given to only two students who have completed their freshman years. The award is based on academic achievement.

She is a member of the Dean's List for scholarship recognition and has participated in numerous extracurricular activities, including tutoring.
