CHARLESTON, IL --A \$1,000 check has been given to the computer management program in Eastern Illinois University's School of Business by the Walgreen Company of Deerfield.

Mark Bomball, associate professor in computer management, said the money is earmarked for faculty recruitment and faculty development in the computer management area.

Walgreen's came to Eastern on a recruiting trip for the first time in 1981. Of the five college graduates the firm hired this year, three were from Eastern, Bomball said. Bomball said Walgreen's interviewed nearly 200 persons in the process.

Bomball was invited to the Deerfield office after representatives of the company came to Eastern. The check was presented to Bomball during his Deerfield visit.
