CHARLESTON, IL--A "Salute to Disney" is the theme of Eastern Illinois University's Homecoming Saturday, Oct. 9. The day's highlights will include the traditional parade, reunion lunches, presentation of Distinguished Alumni Awards, departmental coffee hours, and a football game with Akron University.

Cindy Feitz, a senior from Yorkville, was elected Homecoming Queen by a vote of the student body.

Secretary of State Jim Edgar, class of 1968, and Roger Hibbs, class of 1943, President of Union Carbide's Nuclear Division, are the Distinguished Alumni Award recipients.

Among classes to be honored is the Golden Anniversary class of 1932. The Homecoming play, originally scheduled Moliere's "The Doctor In Spite of Himself," will be "Count Dracula." It will be staged in the Fine Arts Theatre on Friday and Saturday at 8 p.m. and on Sunday, Oct. 10 at 2 p.m.

The parade around the business area starts at 10 a.m. and the football game begins at 1:30 p.m. in O'Brien Stadium.
